Vaccines recommended in B.C.



FOR INFANTS, CHILDREN AND TEENS

2 MONTHS

- Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, hepatitis B, polio, Haemophilus influenzae type b (DTaP-HB-IPV-Hib) vaccine
- Pneumococcal conjugate (PCV 20) vaccine
- Meningococcal C conjugate vaccine
- Rotavirus vaccine

6 MONTHS

- Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, hepatitis B, polio, Haemophilus influenzae type b (DTaP-HB-IPV-Hib) vaccine
- Hepatitis A vaccine (for Indigenous children only)

12 MONTHS

- Pneumococcal conjugate (PCV 20) vaccine
- Meningococcal C conjugate vaccine
- Measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR) vaccine
- Chickenpox (varicella) vaccine

BETWEEN 4 & 6 YEARS-OLD

- Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis, polio (Tdap-IPV) vaccine
- Measles, mumps, rubella, varicella (MMRV) vaccine

14 YEARS-OLD (GRADE 9)

- Meningococcal quadrivalent conjugate vaccine
- Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis (Tdap) vaccine

4 MONTHS

- Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, hepatitis B, polio, Haemophilus influenzae type b (DTaP-HB-IPV-Hib) vaccine
- Pneumococcal conjugate (PCV 20) vaccine
- Rotavirus vaccine

6 MONTHS AND UP

- Influenza (flu) vaccine (yearly) A second dose is needed 4 weeks after the first if receiving the vaccine for the first time.

18 MONTHS

- Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio, Haemophilus influenzae type b (DTap-IPV-Hib) vaccine
- Hepatitis A vaccine (for Indigenous children only)

11 YEARS-OLD (GRADE 6)

- Human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine
